You will be asked about **forty** questions with regards to the following: Initial Research undertaken, Course of Study, English Language Proficiency, Knowledge of T4 student responsibilities and Financial Viability. You will not be expected to know the answer to all the questions, so if you don’t know the answer, please just say, “I don’t know.” If you do not understand the question or cannot hear me properly, please say “I do not understand the question.” or “I didn’t hear you properly.” The question will be repeated once more. If I do not hear your answer clearly, I will ask it one more time. Please keep your answers to no more than three sentences. You need to wait until I have finished asking each question before giving your reply. Do you understand what I have just said? The interview will take about 40 minutes.

We will now begin the interview.”

- What is your current occupation?

- How is the course relevant to your chosen career path?

- Can the same course be studied in your home country and is there a reason for studying it in the UK?

- What is the relevance of your course / qualification to what the prospective student does now or plans to do in future?

- What is your family background e.g. do you have other relatives who have studied to a similar level, or who have studied overseas?

- Do you have any dependants, if so, do you plan to bring them to the UK, If so, how many?

- Why did you choose this college?



- Where did you see this college advertised?
- Have you applied for any other colleges?
- What do you see as the main benefits of studying at this college?
- Where is the college located?
- Do you know anyone who has already studied at the college?
- What are the main courses offered by the college?
- What extracurricular activities (if any) does this college have which attracted you?

Course of Study

- Why did you choose this course?
- Who is the awarding body (what qualification will you receive?) for your course of study?
- What is the duration of the course?



- How does the course fit into your personal career plan?
- What English language level is required before the course starts?

Financial Viability

- Who financed your studies in last three years?
- Who will be financing your studies in the UK?
- What evidence of funding do you have?
- Do you/your sponsors have last three months' bank statement showing the fund dedicated to cover first 12 months of study and maintenance in the UK?
- What is the profession of your financial sponsor and what relationship are they to you?
- Are you able to pay your one year fee up front?
- Do you know how much accommodation will cost per month?
- Do you know you are not entitled to work in the UK whilst studying with ECL?



Knowledge of Tier 4 student responsibilities

- Do you know what your responsibilities as a Tier 4 sponsored student are?
- Do you know how many hours of study you must undertake?
- Do you know if your prospective college is on the Tier 4 sponsors register?
- Do you know what the college's attendance policy is?
- Do you understand a college's responsibilities as a Tier 4 sponsor of students in regard to reporting no shows, poor attendance and poor performance?
